Taylor's continued efforts contribute significantly to the expansion of the NeoCity Technology District in Osceola County by securing the largest Florida Commerce Job Growth Grant award in the program's history, amounting to \$17.5 million for the NeoCity Multi-Use Lab Facilities.

Taylor's efforts have also extended to improving broadband access throughout Florida, securing upwards of \$25 million for the Florida Electric Cooperative. Another significant accomplishment includes obtaining a \$19.9 million grant for the rural City of Arcadia, facilitating the Wastewater Treatment Plant Replacement Phase 1.
